REQUIRED SIGNS

The following signs are required to be posted at building entrances and in common areas of University buildings.

<p>Stop! Feeling Sick?</p> 	<p>October 2023</p>	<p>Required at entrances to buildings Units can also post at entrances to their work area or department</p>
<p>Stay Healthy, Huskies</p> 	<p>October 2023</p>	<p>Required at building entrances, common areas</p>



SIGNS TO BE REMOVED

The signs listed below and any signs or posters *not* listed in this document should be removed from University locations:



- **Stop! Feeling Sick?** and **Stay Healthy, Huskies** posters/signs with a publication date *before* October, 2023.
- Posters/signs that request “Please wash your hands”
- Posters/signs that request “Please wipe down keyboard and area after each use”
- Posters/signs that indicate a “COVID-19 capacity limit”
- Posters/signs that indicate specific areas designated for eating and drinking

<p><i>Masks Are Required</i></p> 	<p>October 2023</p>	<p>May be required at entrance to a UW healthcare facility/patient care area.</p> <p>Refer to the current UW Face Covering Policy for more information.</p>

OPTIONAL SIGNS

TITLE	MOST RECENT PUBLICATION DATE	WHERE TO POST
<p><i>Clean & Disinfect</i></p> 	<p>July 28, 2020</p>	<p>Optional posting in conference rooms, shared spaces</p> <p>Units can also choose to post near high-touch points such as countertops, desks, handles, and shared electronic equipment.</p>
<p><i>Wash Your Hands the Right Way</i></p> 	<p>July 2020</p>	<p>Optional posting in restrooms, shared spaces</p> <p>Units can also choose to post near high-touch points and sanitizing stations.</p>
