The Motorboat Operator Instructor Training Course (MOITC) is for experienced motorboat operators who have a desire to teach courses, specifically the Motorboat Operator Training Course (MOTC). This hands-on training includes practical exercises and classroom instruction according to standards maintained by the Scientific Boating Safety Association and U.S. Department of Interior.

- Maximum 3:1 ratio of MOITC students to instructor on-water modules
- > Has reciprocity with the DOI's M.O.I.C.C.

Prerequisites

- Possess a WA State Boater Education Card
- Completed or renewed MOTC within previous 5 years
- Demonstrated passion for teaching and promoting boating safety
- Assist with instructing at least 8 hours of MOTC
- Approval from your supervisor to participate in MOITC + teach at future MOTCs





Participating in the MOITC and instructing during subsequent MOTCs represents a significant time commitment. If you are interested in becoming an MOTC instructor on behalf of your department, please contact UW's Boating Safety Office.

*MOITC must be completed within 60 days of start of instruction
