MOTORBOAT OPERATOR TRAINING COURSE

The Motorboat Operator Training Course (MOTC) is recommended for all University of Washington personnel who operate motorized watercraft less than 65 feet in length to perform their duties. The hands-on course provides specific motorboat handling techniques and knowledge through classroom lectures, practical field exercises, and on-water exercises according to standards maintained by the Scientific Boating Safety Association and U.S. Department of Interior (DOI).
